

A message from Chief Executive Officer Thomas Reynolds

Since moving back to Washington state and taking the reins of Northwest Harvest, in the summer of 2017, I have been amazed and humbled by the outpouring of support for this organization. Across the state, we continue to concentrate much of our efforts and resources on supplying healthy and culturally-diverse food to hundreds of food banks, meal programs, and schools where our low-income neighbors come to in their times of need.



July 1, 2017 - June 30, 2018


## REVENUE AND SUPPORT
