## How to Host a Drive:

1. Plan your drive: Get creative! Will you host a competition at your work or school? A one-time collection at an event? Food and fundraising events are a great way to build community and support equitable access to food across Washington.

- **4. Deliver your donations to one of our regional locations:** We have limited transportation capacity, and we are unable to deliver supplies for food drives. We consider your delivery as a part of your donation and only offer pick-up on a limited basis.

Where will your food go? After donations arrive at our warehouses, they are quality checked and packaged for distribution to our network of 400 food programs throughout the state, including our own SODO and Fruitvale Community Markets.
